GOALS FOR THE YEAR 2017

- 1) To have 30 children in our kindergarten, 15 with disability and 15 without disability.
- 2) HAVE 30 CHILDREN IN THE SPECIAL NEEDS CLASS
- 3) TO HAVE 71 YOUTH WITH DISABILITY JOIN THE VOCATIONAL TRAINING.
- 4) TO BE ABLE TO RUN 8 AWARENESS CAMPAIGNS
- 5) TO DO 300 ASSESSMENTS AT THE CENTRE AND 300 ASSESSMENTS IN REMOTE AREAS.
- 6) TO HAVE 3 STAFF TRAININGS.
- 7) TO HAVE A PERFORMANCE GROUP OF 20 CHILDREN FORMED.
- 8) To have a school choir of 20 formed
- 9) To have 25 weeks of therapy and training to caregivers involving 250 caregivers.
- 10) To continue with outreach in 13 districts.
- 11) TO BE ABLE TO GET PUBLIC ENDORSEMENT FROM A MINISTER.
- 12) TO INCREASE SALES AND USE OF THE CENTRE SHOP.
