



YES Kilimanjaro Foundation Statutes

§ 1. Mission

Main objective

The Foundation has as its objective to contribute to social, cultural and economical development in the Kilimanjaro region in Tanzania, to promote sustainable development, as described in the UN Sustainable Development Goals. It is a key measure to include persons with disabilities in all our activities.

Objectives:

1. Support education and training of youth, women and other villagers who otherwise would not have a possibility of finding income generating work.
2. Promote agriculture and agricultural related employment to ensure food supply in the local community, healthy nutrition and a sustainable environment.
3. Contribute to small scale industries within agriculture and handicrafts with a basis in local resources.
4. Stimulate environmental friendly tourist services based on the local culture giving the visitors a meaningful experience while at the same time benefiting the local population.
5. Create and arrange for spare time activities for young people through sports, culture, communication and knowledge promotion.
6. Strengthen international cooperation and cultural understanding through mutual exchange visits.

§ 2. The Board of the Foundation

The board must consist of three to six members and one to two substitute representatives. The election period is two years. The substitute members receive all documents.

For the board to be able to make a decision, at least half of the board members need to be present. The board constitutes itself. The board chooses a registered public accountant.

§ 3. Registration

The foundation is registered according to the Norwegian official registration requirements.

§ 4. The administration of the Foundation's finances

The board is responsible for the administration and distribution of the funds.

§ 5. Changing the statutes

Suggestions for changing the statutes must be presented to the board one month ahead of the discussion. To change the statutes, the consent of a complete board is needed.

§ 6. Dissolving the YES Kilimanjaro Foundation

A consenting complete board can dissolve the Foundation. Potential remaining funds shall benefit initiatives supporting the objectives of the Foundation.
